## **DEVOTION TO MARY (OUR SORROWFUL MOTHER)**

Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows: **Sept 15**, immediately following the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.



## THE SEVEN SORROWS

- 1) The Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2: 34-35)
- 2) The Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2: 13-21)
- 3) The Loss of Jesus for Three Days (Luke 2: 41-50)
- 4) The Carrying of the Cross (John 19: 17)
- 5) The Crucifixion of Jesus (John 19: 18-30)
- 6) Jesus Taken Down from the Cross (John 19: 39-40)
- 7) Jesus Laid in the Tomb (John 19: 39-42)

Mary presented 7 promises to St. Bridget of Sweden to those who devote themselves to the <u>7 sorrows</u> of her heart. Mary asks that the devotee prays one Hail Mary in honor of each of her sorrows (**7 Hail Marys**):

- 1) "I will grant peace to their families."
- 2) "They will be enlightened about the divine Mysteries."
- 3) "I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work."
- 4) "I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable Will of My Divine Son or the sanctification of their souls."
- 5) "I will <u>defend them in their spiritual battles</u> with the infernal enemy and I will <u>protect</u> them at <u>every</u> <u>instant</u> of their lives."
- 6) "I will visibly help them at the moment of their death they will see the face of their Mother."
- 7) "I have obtained this grace from My divine Son, that those who <u>propagate this devotion</u> to My tears and sorrows will be <u>taken directly</u> from this earthly life <u>to eternal happiness</u>, since all their sins will be forgiven and My Son will be their eternal consolation and joy."
- St. Alphonsus Liguori revealed Jesus' 4 promises for those who devote themselves to Mary's seven sorrows:
  - 1) "That those who invoke the divine mother by her sorrows, before death will merit to obtain <u>true repentance</u> of all their sins."
  - 2) "That He will protect such in their <u>tribulations</u>, especially at the hour of death."
  - "That He will impress upon them the <u>memory of</u> <u>His Passion</u>, and that they shall have their reward for it in heaven."
  - 4) "That He will commit such devout servants to the hands of Mary, that she may dispose of them according to her pleasure, and <u>obtain</u> for them all the graces she desires."
